- (II) APPLIES FOR A SALVAGE CERTIFICATE ON A FORM PROVIDED BY THE ADMINISTRATION; AND
  - (III) PAYS A FEE ESTABLISHED BY THE ADMINISTRATION.
- (C) (1) AN INSURANCE COMPANY SHALL APPLY FOR A SALVAGE CERTIFICATE ON A FORM PROVIDED BY THE ADMINISTRATION.
- (2) THE APPLICATION UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE ACCOMPANIED BY:
  - (I) THE CERTIFICATE OF TITLE OF THE VEHICLE;
- (II) A CERTIFICATION STATEMENT BY THE INSURANCE COMPANY THAT:
- 1. THE COST TO REPAIR THE VEHICLE FOR LEGAL HIGHWAY OPERATION IS GREATER THAN THE FAIR MARKET VALUE OF THE VEHICLE PRIOR TO SUSTAINING THE DAMAGE FOR WHICH THE CLAIM WAS PAID;
- 2. THE COST TO REPAIR THE VEHICLE FOR LEGAL HIGHWAY OPERATION IS EQUAL TO OR LESS THAN THE FAIR MARKET VALUE OF THE VEHICLE PRIOR TO SUSTAINING THE DAMAGE FOR WHICH THE CLAIM WAS PAID;
- 3. THE VEHICLE IS NOT REBUILDABLE, WILL BE USED FOR PARTS ONLY, AND IS NOT TO BE RETITLED; OR
  - 4. THE VEHICLE HAS BEEN STOLEN; AND
  - (III) A FEE ESTABLISHED BY THE ADMINISTRATION.
- (3) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF § 13–507(C)(2) OF THIS SUBTITLE, A SALVAGE CERTIFICATE ISSUED UNDER THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL CONTAIN A CONSPICUOUS NOTATION BY THE ADMINISTRATION THAT DESCRIBES WHICH OF THE CERTIFICATIONS STATEMENTS UNDER PARAGRAPH (2)(II) OF THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES TO THE VEHICLE.
- (D) (1) AN AUTOMOTIVE DISMANTLER AND RECYCLER MAY APPLY FOR A SALVAGE CERTIFICATE ON A FORM PROVIDED BY THE ADMINISTRATION.
- (2) THE APPLICATION UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE ACCOMPANIED BY:
- (I) THE DOCUMENT THROUGH WHICH OWNERSHIP OF THE VEHICLE WAS TRANSFERRED ACQUIRED; AND
  - (II) A FEE ESTABLISHED BY THE ADMINISTRATION.
