

(II) APPLIES FOR A SALVAGE CERTIFICATE ON A FORM PROVIDED BY THE ADMINISTRATION; AND

(III) PAYS A FEE ESTABLISHED BY THE ADMINISTRATION.

(C) (1) AN INSURANCE COMPANY SHALL APPLY FOR A SALVAGE CERTIFICATE ON A FORM PROVIDED BY THE ADMINISTRATION.

(2) THE APPLICATION UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE ACCOMPANIED BY:

(I) THE CERTIFICATE OF TITLE OF THE VEHICLE;

(II) A ~~CERTIFICATION~~ STATEMENT BY THE INSURANCE COMPANY THAT:

1. THE COST TO REPAIR THE VEHICLE FOR ~~LEGAL~~ HIGHWAY OPERATION IS GREATER THAN THE FAIR MARKET VALUE OF THE VEHICLE PRIOR TO SUSTAINING THE DAMAGE FOR WHICH THE CLAIM WAS PAID;

2. THE COST TO REPAIR THE VEHICLE FOR ~~LEGAL~~ HIGHWAY OPERATION IS EQUAL TO OR LESS THAN THE FAIR MARKET VALUE OF THE VEHICLE PRIOR TO SUSTAINING THE DAMAGE FOR WHICH THE CLAIM WAS PAID;

3. THE VEHICLE IS NOT REBUILDABLE, WILL BE USED FOR PARTS ONLY, AND IS NOT TO BE RETITLED; OR

4. THE VEHICLE HAS BEEN STOLEN; AND

(III) A FEE ESTABLISHED BY THE ADMINISTRATION.

(3) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF § 13-507(C)(2) OF THIS SUBTITLE, A SALVAGE CERTIFICATE ISSUED UNDER THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL CONTAIN A CONSPICUOUS NOTATION BY THE ADMINISTRATION THAT DESCRIBES WHICH OF THE ~~CERTIFICATIONS~~ STATEMENTS UNDER PARAGRAPH (2)(II) OF THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES TO THE VEHICLE.

(D) (1) AN AUTOMOTIVE DISMANTLER AND RECYCLER MAY APPLY FOR A SALVAGE CERTIFICATE ON A FORM PROVIDED BY THE ADMINISTRATION.

(2) THE APPLICATION UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE ACCOMPANIED BY:

(I) THE DOCUMENT THROUGH WHICH OWNERSHIP OF THE VEHICLE WAS ~~TRANSFERRED~~ ACQUIRED; AND

(II) A FEE ESTABLISHED BY THE ADMINISTRATION.
