SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

# Article 28 - Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission

2-101.

(A) The Commission shall be composed of ten members, five of whom shall be residents and registered voters of Montgomery County and five of whom shall be residents and registered voters of Prince George's County. Of the members of the Commission from each county, not more than three shall be members of the same political party. All members shall be persons of ability, experience and integrity and may not be selected as representing or supporting any special interest or interests. All members of the Commission to be appointed from Prince George's County shall be appointed by the County Executive subject to the approval of the County Council. Upon submission of the name of the appointment not less than ten days and not more than 20 days after submission. If the Council fails to act to confirm or reject the appointment within 30 days of the submission to the Council by the County Executive, the appointment stands approved. A vote of a majority of the full County Council is required to confirm or reject
