- (c) When a commissioner has any interest as described in this section which is or reasonably may be incompatible with or in conflict with any of [his] THE COMMISSIONER'S official duties or acts, [he] THE COMMISSIONER shall disclose the interest in a regular public meeting of the Commission or the planning boards and the disclosure shall appear in the minutes, and [he shall disqualify himself and not participate] THE COMMISSIONER IS DISQUALIFIED AND MAY NOT PARTICIPATE in the decision or act affected thereby.
- (d) Any commissioner convicted of violating subsection (a) or (b) of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or six months in jail, or both fine and imprisonment, or by suspension from the Commission or employment for not more than six months, or by outright forfeiture and removal from office, or by any combination of these, as in the discretion of the court is fit and proper.
- (e) The provisions of this section are severable and are as provided in Article 1, § 23 of the [Annotated] Code [of Maryland].
