

(VI) "PAYMENT" MEANS ANY PAYMENT OR CONTRIBUTION OF MONEY OR PROPERTY OR THE INCURRING OF ANY LIABILITY OR PROMISE OF ANYTHING OF VALUE TO A TREASURER OF A CANDIDATE OR OF A CONTINUING POLITICAL COMMITTEE.

(VII) "POLITICAL ACTION COMMITTEE" MEANS A POLITICAL COMMITTEE THAT IS NOT:

1. A POLITICAL PARTY;
2. A CENTRAL COMMITTEE;
3. A SLATE; OR
4. A POLITICAL COMMITTEE ORGANIZED AND OPERATED BY, AND SOLELY ON BEHALF OF:
 - A. AN INDIVIDUAL RUNNING FOR ANY ELECTIVE OFFICE; OR
 - B. A SLATE.

(VIII) "SLATE" MEANS A GROUP, COMBINATION, OR ORGANIZATION OF CANDIDATES CREATED PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE.

(IX) "TREASURER" INCLUDES A SUBTREASURER.

(2) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A CONTRIBUTOR, MEMBER, OR POLITICAL ACTION COMMITTEE IS SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 28, TITLE 9 OF THE CODE IF A PAYMENT IS MADE BY THE CONTRIBUTOR, OR A TRANSFER IS MADE BY THE POLITICAL ACTION COMMITTEE, TO THE TREASURER OF THE CANDIDATE OR THE TREASURER OF THE CANDIDATE'S CONTINUING POLITICAL COMMITTEE.

(3) ARTICLE 28, TITLE 9 OF THE CODE DOES NOT APPLY TO:

(I) ANY PAYMENT OR TRANSFER TO A SLATE, UNLESS THE SLATE IS COMPOSED SOLELY OF CANDIDATES OR MEMBERS;

(II) ANY TRANSFER TO THE CONTINUING POLITICAL COMMITTEE OF A CANDIDATE OR MEMBER BY THE CONTINUING POLITICAL COMMITTEE OF ANOTHER INDIVIDUAL RUNNING FOR ELECTIVE OFFICE; OR

(III) A PAYMENT OR TRANSFER TO THE PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE, OR STATE CENTRAL COMMITTEE, OF A POLITICAL PARTY, EVEN IF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE SUPPORTS A CANDIDATE.

(4) A PERSON MAY NOT MAKE A PAYMENT IN VIOLATION OF ARTICLE 28, § 9-102(A) OF THE CODE.
