

(E) AN INDIVIDUAL MAY PERFORM X-RAY DUTIES WITHOUT A LICENSE ONLY IF THE DUTIES:

(1) DO NOT INCLUDE:

(I) COMPUTERIZED OR NONCOMPUTERIZED TOMOGRAPHY;

(II) FLUOROSCOPY;

(III) INVASIVE RADIOLOGY;

(IV) MAMMOGRAPHY;

(V) NUCLEAR MEDICINE;

(VI) RADIATION THERAPY; OR

(VII) XEROGRAPHY.

(2) ARE LIMITED TO X-RAYS OF THE:

(I) CHEST, ANTERIOR-POSTERIOR AND LATERAL;

(II) SPINE, ANTERIOR-POSTERIOR AND LATERAL; OR

(III) EXTREMITIES, ANTERIOR-POSTERIOR AND LATERAL, NOT INCLUDING THE HEAD.

(III) BY AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS:

1. TAKEN A 20-HOUR COURSE CONSISTING OF AT LEAST 20 30 HOURS OF TRAINING IN PERFORMING X-RAY PROCEDURES APPROVED BY THE MARYLAND RADIOLOGICAL SOCIETY IN CONSULTATION WITH THE MARYLAND SOCIETY OF RADIATION RADIOLOGIC TECHNOLOGISTS; AND
