- (E) AN INDIVIDUAL MAY PERFORM X-RAY DUTIES WITHOUT A LICENSE ONLY IF THE DUTIES:
 - (1) DO NOT INCLUDE:
- (I) COMPUTERIZED OR NONCOMPUTERIZED TOMOGRAPHY;
 - (II) FLUOROSCOPY:
 - (III) INVASIVE RADIOLOGY;
 - (IV) MAMMOGRAPHY;
 - (V) NUCLEAR MEDICINE;
 - (VI) RADIATION THERAPY; OR
 - (VII) XEROGRAPHY.
 - (2) ARE LIMITED TO X-RAYS OF THE:
 - (I) CHEST, ANTERIOR-POSTERIOR AND LATERAL;
 - (II) SPINE, ANTERIOR-POSTERIOR AND LATERAL; OR
- (III) EXTREMITIES, ANTERIOR-POSTERIOR AND LATERAL, NOT INCLUDING THE HEAD.
 - (2) (3) ARE PERFORMED:
- (I) BY AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS NOT EMPLOYED PRIMARILY TO PERFORM X-RAY DUTIES; AND
- (II) IN THE MEDICAL OFFICE OF THE PHYSICIAN WHO DELEGATES THE DUTIES; AND
 - (3) ARE DELEGATED BY A LICENSED PHYSICIAN WHO HAS:
- (I) PROVIDED THE INDIVIDUAL 20 HOURS OF TRAINING IN PERFORMING X RAY PROCEDURES: AND
- (II) OBSERVED AND TESTED THE INDIVIDUAL TO ASSURE SAFETY AND COMPETENCE IN PERFORMING THE DUTIES.
 - (III) BY AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS:
- 1. TAKEN A 20 HOUR COURSE CONSISTING OF AT LEAST 20 30 HOURS OF TRAINING IN PERFORMING X-RAY PROCEDURES APPROVED BY THE MARYLAND RADIOLOGICAL SOCIETY IN CONSULTATION WITH THE MARYLAND SOCIETY OF RADIATION RADIOLOGIC TECHNOLOGISTS; AND
