- (B) ANY SUBDIVISION WHICH REQUIRES A LOCAL LICENSE UNDER THIS SECTION MAY NOT DISCRIMINATE AGAINST APPLICANTS WHO ARE NOT RESIDENTS OF THAT SUBDIVISION.
- (C) IN THE EVENT THAT ANY SUBDIVISION WHICH REQUIRES A LOCAL LICENSE DISCONTINUES THAT REQUIREMENT AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT, THAT SUBDIVISION MAY NOT THEREAFTER ADOPT A LICENSE REQUIREMENT.
- (D) A STATE LICENSE IS REQUIRED TO PROVIDE HEATING, VENTILATION, AIR-CONDITIONING, OR REFRIGERATION SERVICES ANYWHERE WITHIN THE STATE, WHETHER OR NOT THE INDIVIDUAL HOLDS A LOCAL LICENSE.

## SUBTITLE 6. SHORT TITLE; TERMINATION OF TITLE

9A-601.

THIS TITLE MAY BE CITED AS THE "MARYLAND HEATING, VENTILATION, AIR-CONDITIONING, AND REFRIGERATION CONTRACTORS ACT".

9A-602.

SUBJECT TO THE EVALUATION AND REESTABLISHMENT PROVISIONS OF THE MARYLAND PROGRAM EVALUATION ACT, THIS TITLE AND ALL REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THIS TITLE SHALL TERMINATE AND BE OF NO EFFECT AFTER JULY 1, 2003.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of the initial members of the State Advisory Board of Heating, Ventilation, Air-Conditioning, and Refrigeration Contractors shall expire as follows:

- (1) 2 members in <del>1993</del> 1994;
- (2) 2 members in <del>1994</del> 1995; and
- (3) 3 members in <del>1995</del> 1996.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, of the initial members of the Board, 2 shall be current or former members of a board that administers a heating, ventilation, air-conditioning, and refrigeration contractors license program in a political subdivision of the State.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the requirements for licensure of heating, ventilation, air-conditioning and refrigeration contractors established by this Act shall take effect January 1, 1993 1994.
