- [(a)] A tax collector shall assess interest on unpaid tax from the due date to the date on which the tax is paid if a person who is required to estimate and pay financial institution franchise tax, PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY FRANCHISE TAX, or income tax under [§ 8–209, § 10–815, or § 10–816] § 8–210(B), § 8–405(B), OR § 10–902 of this article:
 - (1) fails to pay an installment when due; or
 - (2) estimates a tax that is:
- (i) less than 90% of the tax required to be shown on the return for the current taxable year; and
 - (ii) less than the tax paid for the prior taxable year.
- [(b) The Department shall assess interest on the difference between 45% of the tax due for a year and the estimated tax paid from the date on which the estimated tax is due to the date the estimated tax is paid, if a person who is required to estimate and pay public service company franchise tax under § 8-404(b) of this article:
 - (1) fails to pay the estimated tax when due; or
- (2) estimates a tax that is less than 90% of the tax required to be shown on the return for the current taxable year.]

 - (1) fails to pay an installment when due; or
 - (2) estimates a tax that is:
- (i) less than 90% of the tax required to be shown on the return for the current taxable year; and
 - (ii) less than the tax paid for the prior taxable year.
