Comptroller to issue a micro brewery (on and off sale) license in Dorchester County after [3] 6 years does not affect the ability of a holder of a Class 7 micro brewery license to continue to exercise all the privileges authorized by the license after June 30, [1992] 1995.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 30, 1992.

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 68.

This bill would clarify that a court may allocate between the parties in a divorce proceeding additional costs of providing hospital, medical, or surgical benefits under a group insurance contract.

House Bill 97, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 26, 1992, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 68.
