- (2) DORCHESTER COUNTY;
- (3) QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY;
- (3) (4) SOMERSET COUNTY; AND
- (4) (5) WORCESTER COUNTY.
- (B) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING SERVICES TO COUNTY RESIDENTS:
- (1) THE TESTING OF APPLICANTS FOR THE ISSUANCE OF DRIVERS' LICENSES;
  - (2) THE ISSUANCE OF DRIVERS' LICENSES; AND
  - (3) OTHER DRIVER LICENSING RELATED SERVICES.
- (C) THE SERVICES <u>REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS</u> SECTION SHALL BE PROVIDED <del>AT A MINIMUM OF 2 DAYS PER MONTH.</del>
- (D) THE SERVICES SHALL BE PROVIDED FOR A MINIMUM OF 2 DAYS EACH MONTH AT THE COUNTY SEAT OF EACH RESPECTIVE COUNTY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 250.

This bill would authorize Washington County to issue general obligation bonds which may not exceed \$30,000,000 in total at any time.

House Bill 143, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 12, 1992, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 250.
