(C) WHILE PERFORMING THE DUTIES OF THAT EMPLOYMENT, AN INDIVIDUAL EMPLOYED BY ANY AGENCY OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT, COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM, STATE APPROVED NONPUBLIC SCHOOL FOR HANDICAPPED CHILDREN, CHARTERED EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION OF THIS STATE, OR THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION MAY USE ANY OF THE TITLES LISTED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.

2-403.

A person may not knowingly make a false, material statement in an application for a license or a limited license or for renewal of a license or a limited license.

2-404.

A person may not materially alter a license or a limited license with fraudulent intent.

2-405.

A person may not transfer or offer to transfer a license or a limited license for consideration.

2-408.

A person who violates any provision of this title is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$500 or imprisonment not exceeding 90 days or both.

2-501.

This title may be cited as the “Maryland Audiologists, HEARING AID DEALERS, AND SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGISTS Act”.

2-502.

Subject to the evaluation and reestablishment provisions of the Program Evaluation Act, this title and all rules and regulations adopted under this title shall terminate and be of no effect after July 1, 1994.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That nothing in this Act affects the term of a current member of the State Board of Examiners for Audiologists, the State Board of Examiners for Hearing Aid Dealers, or the State Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathologists. An individual who is a member of the State Board of Examiners for Audiologists, the State Board of Examiners for Hearing Aid Dealers, or
