4A 913. PROCEDURE BY DEPARTMENT AFTER ACCEPTANCE OF ARTICLES OF DISSOLUTION AND ARTICLES OF CANCELLATION.

- (A) AFTER THE DEPARTMENT ACCEPTS ARTICLES OF DISSOLUTION OR ARTICLES OF CANCELLATION FOR RECORD, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PUBLISH A NOTICE THAT NAMES THE LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY AND STATES THAT ITS ARTICLES OF DISSOLUTION OR ARTICLES OF CANCELLATION HAVE BEEN ACCEPTED FOR RECORD BY THE DEPARTMENT.
- (B) THE NOTICE UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE PUBLISHED ONCE A WEEK FOR 4 SUCCESSIVE WEEKS IN A NEWSPAPER OF GENERAL CIRCULATION IN THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE PRINCIPAL OFFICE OF THE LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY IS LOCATED.
- (C) FAILURE OF THE DEPARTMENT TO PUBLISH THE NOTICE OF THE ARTICLES OF CANCELLATION DOES NOT INVALIDATE THE DISSOLUTION OR CANCELLATION.

SUBTITLE 10. FOREIGN LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANIES 4A-1001. GOVERNING LAW.

- (A) SUBJECT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF THIS STATE:
- (1) THE LAWS OF THE STATE UNDER WHICH A FOREIGN LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY IS ORGANIZED GOVERN ITS ORGANIZATION, INTERNAL AFFAIRS, AND THE LIABILITY OF ITS MEMBERS; AND
- (2) A FOREIGN LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY MAY NOT BE DENIED REGISTRATION BY REASON OF ANY DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THOSE LAWS AND THE LAWS OF THIS STATE.
- (B) A FOREIGN LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY MAY NOT DO ANY KIND OF INTRASTATE, INTERSTATE, OR FOREIGN BUSINESS IN THIS STATE WHICH THE LAWS OF THIS STATE PROHIBIT A DOMESTIC LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY FROM DOING.

4A-1002. REGISTRATION

- (A) BEFORE DOING ANY INTERSTATE, INTRASTATE, OR FOREIGN BUSINESS IN THIS STATE, A FOREIGN LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY SHALL REGISTER WITH THE DEPARTMENT.
- (B) IN ORDER TO REGISTER, A FOREIGN LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY SHALL SUBMIT TO THE DEPARTMENT AN APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION AS A FOREIGN LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY EXECUTED BY AN AUTHORIZED PERSON AND SETTING FORTH:
