- (a) In addition to the powers set forth elsewhere in this title, the Board may adopt rules, regulations, and bylaws as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of this title.
  - (b) In addition to the duties set forth elsewhere in this title, the Board shall:
    - (1) Keep a current record of all registered environmental sanitarians;
    - (2) Collect and account for fees provided under this title;
- (3) Pay all necessary expenses of the Board in accordance with the State budget;
  - (4) Keep a complete record of its proceedings;
- (5) File an annual report of its activities, including a financial statement, with the Governor and the Secretary; AND
- (6) [Provide each registered environmental sanitarian with a copy of the bylaws, rules, and regulations of the Board; and
  - (7)] Adopt an official seal.

11-301.

- (a) Except as otherwise provided in this title, [after July 1, 1986, all environmental sanitarians shall be licensed by the Board.
- (b) An individual shall be licensed as a registered environmental sanitarian by the Board before the individual may:
  - (1) Use the title "registered environmental sanitarian";
  - (2) Use the initials "R.S." after the name of the person; or
- (3) Represent to the public that the individual is a registered environmental sanitarian] AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL BE LICENSED BY THE BOARD BEFORE THE INDIVIDUAL MAY PRACTICE AS A REGISTERED ENVIRONMENTAL SANITARIAN IN THIS STATE.
  - (B) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO:
    - (1) A SANITARIAN-IN-TRAINING;
- (2) A STUDENT PARTICIPATING IN A FIELD EXPERIENCE AS PART OF AN EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM; AND
- IN ANY THE FOLLOWING JOB INDIVIDUAL AN IS PERFORMING THE **FUNCTIONS** AN CLASSIFICATIONS ARE INCIDENTAL TO ENVIRONMENTAL SANITARIAN WHICH THE INDIVIDUAL'S NORMAL DUTIES:
  - (I) INDUSTRIAL HYGIENISTS;
