- (XIV) PARAPROFESSIONAL SANITARIAN AIDES AND TECHNICIANS;
- (XV) PERSONS EMPLOYED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES OR RELATED COUNTY DEPARTMENTS WHO PERFORM DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES UNDER THE NATURAL RESOURCES ARTICLE; AND
