- (III) THE EXCLUSION PROVIDED UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH ONLY APPLIES WHEN THE PHYSICIAN OR OTHER LICENSED OR CERTIFIED PERSON IS RENDERING CARE TO A MEMBER OR SUBSCRIBER OF THE HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION UNDER A SALARIED OR CAPITATED SYSTEM.
- (3) "HOSPITAL" MEANS HOSPITAL AS DEFINED IN § 19–301(F) OF THE HEALTH GENERAL ARTICLE.
- (B) THE COMMISSIONER SHALL ADOPT BY REGULATION AS THE UNIFORM CLAIMS FORM FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF HOSPITAL SERVICES IN THIS STATE THE UNIFORM CLAIMS FORM ADOPTED BY THE NATIONAL UNIFORM BILLING COMMISSION AND APPROVED BY THE HEALTH CARE FINANCING ADMINISTRATION FOR HOSPITAL PAYMENTS UNDER TITLE XVIII OF THE SOCIAL SECURITY ACT.
- (C) THE COMMISSIONER SHALL ADOPT BY REGULATION A UNIFORM CLAIMS FORM FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONERS' SERVICES.

To register as an administrator an applicant must present evidence satisfactory to the Commissioner that the applicant:

- (1) Has not been convicted of any:
 - (i) Felony;
 - (ii) Misdemeanor involving moral turpitude;
 - (iii) Violation of any provision of this subtitle;
- (iv) Attempt or conspiracy to commit any of the violations listed under subparagraphs (i) through (iii) of this paragraph; or
- (v) Crime in which any other violation listed under this paragraph is an element;
 - (2) Pursuant to § 664 of this subtitle, has:
 - (i) Obtained the required surety bond; or
- (ii) Qualified for 1 of the applicable exemptions from the bonding requirement; [and]
- (3) Has satisfied any applicable examination requirements adopted by the Commissioner under § 669(b) of this subtitle; AND
- (4) FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF HEALTH BENEFIT PLANS IN THE STATE USES ONLY THE UNIFORM CLAIM FORMS ADOPTED BY THE COMMISSIONER UNDER § 490P OF THIS ARTICLE.
