In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 610.

This bill would create a Joint Legislative Committee on Health Care Delivery and Financing, replacing the current Commission on Health Care Cost Containment and the Joint Committee on the Medical Assistance Program which terminates on June 30, 1992.

House Bill 1148, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 12, 1992, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 610.
