to the election of the members of the Caroline County Board of Education authorizing that, upon the adoption of a certain resolution by the Board of Commissioners of Caroline County, at the general election held in November, 1992, a question shall be placed on the ballot in Caroline County to canvass the opinion of the voters on whether or not the members of the Caroline County Board of Education shall be elected; providing that the results of the straw poll shall have no binding or legal effect; requiring the Board of Supervisors of Elections of Caroline County to take certain actions; and generally relating to a straw poll of the voters of Caroline County at the general election in November, 1992, concerning the election of members of the Caroline County Board of Education.
