3. NEW OR CHANGED LISTING.

(4) The Commission may provide other exemptions that are just and reasonable.

SECTION 3. 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 1-of this Act shall take effect November 1, 1992.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act shall take effect July 1, 1994.

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 1325.

This bill would establish a policy for providing services in the State to children with special needs and provide for development of a plan to return children in out-of-state residential placements to placement within the State.

Senate Bill 588, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 12, 1992, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign House Bill 1325.

AN ACT concerning

Office for Children, Youth, and Families - Children with Disabilities Special Needs - Out-of-State Placement

FOR the purpose of establishing a policy for providing services in the State to children with disabilities special needs and in the least restrictive environment; providing for the development of a plan to return children in out-of-state residential placement to placement within the State; establishing dates for compliance; providing duties for the Office for Children, Youth, and Families; establishing dates for compliance; providing certain specifics to be included in the plan; instructing the Office for Children, Youth, and Families to work with certain individuals and agencies providing for the appointment of a certain committee for a certain purpose;
