## House Bill No. 1346

AN ACT concerning

## Reduction of Toxics in Packaging

FOR the purpose of prohibiting certain manufacturers and distributors from selling or offering for sale or promotional purposes after a certain time certain packaging materials to which certain toxics have been intentionally introduced during the manufacturing or distribution process; establishing by a certain time maximum allowable concentration levels for certain toxics that are incidentally present in certain packaging materials; providing certain exemptions; authorizing a person to apply for a conditional exemption under certain circumstances; authorizing the Department of the Environment to grant certain exemptions under certain circumstances; authorizing the Department to require certain persons to provide certain certificates of compliance under certain circumstances; providing for the form and scope of certain certificates of compliance; authorizing the Department to require the withdrawal of certain packages and packaging components from sale or promotional use within the State under certain circumstances; providing certain civil and criminal penalties for certain violations; authorizing the Department to seek injunctive relief under certain circumstances; requiring authorizing the Department to adopt certain regulations; requiring the Department to submit a certain report to certain persons by a certain date; establishing the contents of the report; defining certain terms; providing that certain steel products shall be considered as single packaging components; and generally relating to the reduction of toxics in packaging.
