A RESOLUTION OF MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF CHEVERLY adopted pursuant to the authority of Article XI-E of the Constitution of Maryland (1981 Replacement Volume and 1991 Cumulative Supplement) and Section 13 of the Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1991 Replacement Volume and 1991 Supplement), to amend the Charter of the Town of Cheverly (as published in Municipal Charters of Maryland, Volume II, 1983 Edition and 1991 Supplement), by repealing Section C-24 of the Charter and enacting a new Section C-24 of the Charter, for the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and Town Council of Cheverly to determine by ordinance various matters pertaining to the manner in which, and the terms and conditions on which, bonds, notes or other evidences of indebtedness of Mayor and Town Council of Cheverly may be issued, sold, delivered, secured and paid; authorizing the issuance and sale of bonds.
