RESOLUTION

PROPOSING THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN LANDS TO THE TOWN OF
QUEENSTOWN

WHEREAS, Queenstown Properties, Inc., a Maryland corporation, and Chesapeake Village Associates Limited Partnership, a Maryland limited partnership (together the "Owners"), are the owners of three tracts of land ("Properties") in Queen Anne's County fronting on Chesapeake Village Road between U.S. Routes 50 and 301, being a portion of certain property proposed for annexation consisting of 31.097 acres, more or less, and lying contiguous to the southern corporate boundaries of the Town of Queenstown ("Annexation Area").
