AN ACT concerning

Animals

FOR the purpose of increasing the penalties for conviction of violating the provisions of this title; authorizing the animal control board to hear cases referred by the animal control division concerning enforcement, authorizing the board to order an animal removed from the county or impounded by animal control; authorizing animal control to obtain a court order authorizing removal, requiring animals be retained at the shelter for thirty days and until expiration of the appeal rights of the owner; providing for certain types of animal collars; authorizing animal control to direct remedies to shelter conditions that affect the health of an animal including veterinary examination and treatment.
