AN ACT to add new Article IIIA, Parking, to Chapter 244, Vehicles and Traffic; to repeal and reenact, with amendments, Subsection I of Section 244–20, Parking Fines, of Article IV, Citations and Penalties; to add new Subsection I to Section 244–20, Parking Fines, of Article IV, Citations and Penalties; to transfer Section 244–17, General Parking Regulations, and Section 244–18, Impoundment and Sale of Vehicles Left Unattended, Record of Towed Vehicles, to new Article IIIA, Parking; to change the title of Article III, Commercial Vehicles and Parking, to Commercial Vehicles, all of Chapter 244, Vehicles and Traffic, of the Harford County Code, as amended; to establish certain prohibitions and rules concerning the stopping, standing, and parking of vehicles; to establish certain exceptions to the prohibitions and rules; to establish fines for violation of these prohibitions; and generally relating to the stopping, standing and parking of vehicles.
