AN EMERGENCY ACT to repeal and reenact, with amendments, the definitions of "sanitary landfill" and "solid waste," to repeal the definition of "rubble," and to add the definition of "rubble landfill," all of Section 109-1, Definitions of Article I, General Provisions, of Chapter 109, Environmental Control; and Section 109-8.2, Rubble Landfills, and Section 109-8.3, Operation of Rubble Landfills, to Article I, General Provisions, of Chapter 109, Environmental Control; to add the definition of "rubble landfill" to Section 267-4, Definitions, of Article I, General Provisions, of Part 1, Standards, of Chapter 267, Zoning; to add new Sections 267-34C(5), 267-35C(5), 267-36C(5), 267-36.1C(4), 267-37C(6), 267-38C(7), 267-39C(9), and 267-40C(10) to Article VI.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Article XV, Economic Development Advisory Board, of Chapter 9, Boards, Councils, Agencies, of the Harford County Code, as amended; to increase and better define the membership of the board; to designate a vice-chair; to change the number necessary to constitute a quorum; and to further provide for an expansion in the duties of the members.

AN ACT to repeal, in its entirety, Article XIII, Housing Commission, of Part 2, Nonbinding Advisory Boards, of Chapter 9, Boards, Councils, Agencies, of the Harford County Code, as amended; and to add new Article XIII, Housing and Community Development Commission, to Part 2, Nonbinding Advisory Boards, of Chapter 9, Boards, Councils, Agencies, of the Harford County Code, as amended; and to further repeal Resolution No. 11–85 and in corporate its concepts in new Article XIII.
