AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Subsection A of Section 256-39.1, heading User benefit assessment, of Article II, heading Joppatowne Sanitary Subdistrict, of Chapter 256 heading Water and Sewers, all of the Harford County Code, as amended; to provide in certain circumstances for an increase in the user benefit assessment in the Joppatowne Sanitary Subdistrict.
