**Bill No. 91-52**

AN ACT to repeal and reenact, with amendments, Section 4-5, Councilmanic Districts, of Article I, Legislative Branch, of Chapter 4, Administration of Government, of the Harford County Code, as amended; to establish new Council districts in lieu of the plan presented by the Redistricting Commission; to list the election precincts of which each Council district is comprised; to show generally the boundary lines of each Council district; and generally relating to Council districts.

**Bill No. 91-53**

AN ACT to add the definitions of tropical hardwood and tropical hardwood products to Section 41-3, Definitions, of Article I, General Provisions, of Chapter 41, Procurement; to add new Section 41-19.1, Tropical Hardwood and Tropical Hardwood Products, to Article III, Purchase Orders and Contracts, of Chapter 41, Procurement, of the Harford County Code, as amended; to prohibit the county from entering into contracts which require the use of tropical hardwood products; to establish certain exceptions to this prohibition; to require that bids on county contracts contain a certain certification; to require that bids without the certification be rejected; to prohibit a person from falsifying the certification; and generally relating to use of tropical hardwood products in county projects.

**Bill No. 91-54**

AN ACT to repeal Article IV, heading, Classified Service, of the Harford County Code, and to add new Article IV, heading, Classified Service, to Chapter 16, heading, Personnel, of the Harford County Code, as amended, to stand in lieu of the repealed Article IV, to provide rules and regulations governing classified employees employed by the government of Harford County, Maryland; and generally relating to the system of personnel administration for Harford County employees in the classified service.

**Bill No. 91-55**

AN ACT to repeal Chapter 202 of the Harford County Code, as amended, heading, PLUMBING, and to enact in lieu thereof, new Chapter 202, heading, PLUMBING, all to be added to the Harford County Code, as amended, to provide that Harford County shall adopt as its plumbing code, the 1990 Maryland State Plumbing Code
