**Bill No. 91-59**

AN ACT to repeal and reenact, with amendments, Section 123-46.1, Homestead Credit, of Article II, Real Property Tax Credits, of Chapter 123, Finance and Taxation, of the Harford County Code, as amended; to require that the County Council annually adopt by a certain date a resolution establishing a homestead credit percentage; to require a public hearing on the resolution; to require that prior notice of the hearing be published; to establish the homestead credit percentage for a certain taxable year; and generally relating to the homestead credit percentage.

**Bill No. 91-62**

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 64-21, Sale of Poultry and Rabbits; of Article IV, Animal Care; Abuse; Cruelty of Chapter 64, Animals, of the Harford County Code as amended, to provide for an exemption from the prohibition against the sale of poultry or rabbits less than eight (8) weeks of age.

**Bill No. 91-65**

AN ACT to add subsections L and M to Section 219-7, Exemptions, of Chapter 219, Signs, of the Harford County Code, as amended; to permit the display of noncommercial flags and certain commercial flags under certain circumstances; and generally relating to display of flags.

AN ACT to add the definition of "fire station assembly hall" to Section 267-4, Definitions, of Article I, General Provisions, to add Subsection C(5) to Section 267-34, AG Agricultural District, of Article VI, District Regulations, to repeal and reenact, with amendments, Subsection C(5) of Section 267-53, Specific Standards, of Article VIII, Special Exceptions, and to repeal and reenact, with amendments, Table I: Principal Permitted Uses for Specific Zoning Districts: Institutional, all of Part 1, Standards, of Chapter 267, Zoning, of the Harford County Code, as amended; to allow fire stations with certain assembly halls in the agricultural zoning
