AN EMERGENCY ACT to:

- (1) increase the rates of the beverage container tax;
- (2) make the increased rates effective on a certain date;
- (3) expand the coverage of the tax to containers for [[certain fruit and vegetable juices,]] alcoholic beverages[[, and other drinks and beverages, and further define the containers that are subject to the tax]];
- (4) allow the County Council to increase or decrease the rates by resolution;
- [[(5) provide for periodic automatic increases in the rates to reflect increases in the Consumer Price Index;]]

[[(6)]] (5) provide a termination date for the rate increases;

- (6) make certain clarifying and stylistic changes; and
- (7) generally amend the law establishing the beverage container tax.

AN EMERGENCY ACT to:

- (2) make the increased rates effective on a certain date <u>and terminate on a certain</u> date;
- (3) allow the County Counci! to increase or decrease the rate of this tax by resolution;
- (4) expand the coverage of the tax by imposing it on rooms rented for more than 7 days but less than a certain period of time; and
