- [[(1) enlarge the safety zone around certain buildings and camps within which guns must not be discharged;]]
- (1) expand the urban area within which a gun cannot be discharged;
- (2) transfer responsibility for recommending changes in the boundary of the urban area;
- amend the process by which the County Council changes the boundary of the urban area;
- [[(2)]] (4) extend certain restrictions on discharge of guns to discharge of [[other dangerous weapons]] bows;
- [[(3)]] (5) delete provisions regarding trespass on public or private land;
- [[(4)]] (6) make technical and stylistic changes; and
- [[(5)]] (7) generally amend the law regarding discharge of [[firearms and other dangerous weapons]] guns and bows in the County.
