

(B) CONDUCT OF HEARINGS.

UNLESS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SUBTITLE OR IN REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER IT, THE COMMISSIONER SHALL HOLD HEARINGS AUTHORIZED BY THIS SUBTITLE IN ACCORDANCE WITH TITLE 10 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.

14-110. CIVIL ENFORCEMENT OF SUBTITLE.**(A) CEASE AND DESIST ORDER.**

THE COMMISSIONER MAY PASS A CEASE AND DESIST ORDER TO STOP A VIOLATION OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(B) INJUNCTION; ACTION TO ENFORCE SUBTITLE.

WHENEVER THE COMMISSIONER FINDS THAT A PERSON HAS VIOLATED OR IS ABOUT TO VIOLATE THIS SUBTITLE OR A REGULATION ADOPTED OR ORDER PASSED UNDER IT, THE COMMISSIONER MAY SUE TO:

(1) ENFORCE THIS SUBTITLE OR THE REGULATION OR ORDER;
OR

(2) ENJOIN THE VIOLATION.

(C) ACTION BY COURT.

(1) ON A PROPER SHOWING, A COURT MAY:

(I) ISSUE A PERMANENT OR PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION OR PASS A RESTRAINING ORDER; AND

(II) APPOINT A RECEIVER OR CONSERVATOR FOR THE DEFENDANT OR THE DEFENDANT'S ASSETS.

(2) THE COURT MAY NOT REQUIRE THE COMMISSIONER TO POST BOND.
