It is revised as a substantive provision, rather than a definition, for accuracy since a "designated agent" is not the "Commissioner", and to clarify the apparent intent of the General Assembly to allow delegation of any responsibility under this subtitle.

14-206. REGULATIONS.

THE COMMISSIONER MAY ADOPT AND ENFORCE REGULATIONS TO ADMINISTER AND ENFORCE THIS SUBTITLE.

14-207. PUBLICATION OF INFORMATION.

(A) ABOUT VIOLATIONS OF SUBTITLE.

THE COMMISSIONER MAY PUBLISH INFORMATION ABOUT VIOLATIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(B) PUBLIC INFORMATION.

UNDER REGULATIONS THAT THE COMMISSIONER ADOPTS, THE COMMISSIONER MAY MAKE AVAILABLE TO ANY PERSON ANY INFORMATION SUBMITTED TO THE COMMISSIONER.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 56, §§ 356D and 364(a)(4).

Subsection (b) of this section is revised to apply to "any information" submitted to the Commissioner, rather than the former list of specific information that may be made available to the public, for clarity.
