

(2) AN APPLICANT WHO USES AN INTERPRETER SHALL PAY THE COST OF THE INTERPRETER.

REVISOR'S NOTE: Subsection (a) of this section is new language added to avoid the former repetition of "registration, certification, or licensure".

Subsections (b) and (c) of this section are new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 41, § 8-102(f).

In subsections (b) and (c)(1) of this section, the broad reference to a "unit in the Department" is substituted for the former narrow reference to a "board or commission" to clarify that there are entities in the Department other than boards and commissions.

In subsection (b) of this section, the reference to a determination of need with respect to "engag[ing] in the business or occupation for which the license is sought" is substituted for the former reference to a determination of the ability as "necessary and bear[ing] a reasonable relationship to the applicant for registration, certification, or licensure" for brevity and clarity.

In subsection (c)(1) of this section, the reference to a testing procedure "for a license" is added for clarity.

Also in subsection (c)(1) of this section, the phrase "on request" is added to state expressly that which only was implied by the reference, in former Art. 41, § 8-102(f)(2), to an "applicant ... who requests the use of an interpreter".

In subsection (c)(2) of this section, the reference to an applicant "who is allowed to use an interpreter" is substituted for the former reference to one "who requests" the use to be more precise.

GENERAL REVISOR'S NOTE TO SUBTITLE:

Former Art. 41, § 8-106, which abolished the central licensing office and transferred its functions to the Secretary, is deleted as obsolete, since the transfer and other events contemplated already have occurred. See also Title 10, Subtitle 7 of the State Government Article, which vests the property and obligations of an abolished unit in the successor unit and keeps the rules, regulations, orders, hearings, and proceedings of an abolished unit in effect.
