16-204. APPLICATIONS FOR LICENSES.

(A) LICENSE TO ACT AS A MANUFACTURER'S WAREHOUSE OPERATOR.

AN APPLICANT FOR A LICENSE TO ACT AS A MANUFACTURER'S WAREHOUSE OPERATOR SHALL:

(1) SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE COMPTROLLER:

(I) ON THE FORM AND CONTAINING THE INFORMATION THAT THE COMPTROLLER REQUIRES; AND

(II) IDENTIFYING AND DESCRIBING EACH WAREHOUSE WHERE CIGARETTES WILL BE STORED; AND

(2) PAY TO THE COMPTROLLER AN APPLICATION FEE OF \$250 FOR EACH WAREHOUSE.

(B) LICENSE TO ACT AS A RETAILER.

(1) AN APPLICANT FOR A LICENSE TO ACT AS A RETAILER SHALL:

(I) OBTAIN THE COUNTY LICENSE REQUIRED UNDER § 16-301 OF THIS TITLE;

(II) SUBMIT TO THE CLERK AN APPLICATION FOR EACH PERMANENT OR TEMPORARY PLACE OF BUSINESS LOCATED IN THE SAME ENCLOSURE AND OPERATED BY THE SAME APPLICANT; AND

(III) PAY TO THE CLERK AN APPLICATION FEE OF \$3.

(2) THE APPLICATION SHALL:

(I) BE MADE ON THE FORM THAT THE CLERK REQUIRES; AND

(II) CONTAIN THE INFORMATION THAT THE COMPTROLLER REQUIRES.

(C) LICENSE TO ACT AS A SUBWHOLESALER.

AN APPLICANT FOR A LICENSE TO ACT AS A SUBWHOLESALER SHALL:

(1) SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE COMPTROLLER ON THE FORM AND CONTAINING THE INFORMATION THAT THE COMPTROLLER REQUIRES; AND
