

(1) FRAUDULENTLY OR DECEPTIVELY OBTAINS OR ATTEMPTS TO OBTAIN A LICENSE FOR THE APPLICANT OR LICENSEE OR FOR ANOTHER PERSON;

(2) FRAUDULENTLY OR DECEPTIVELY USES A LICENSE;

(3) FAILS TO COMPLY WITH THE MARYLAND CIGARETTE SALES BELOW COST ACT OR REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THAT ACT; OR

(4) BUYS CIGARETTES FOR RESALE:

(I) IN VIOLATION OF A LICENSE; OR

(II) FROM A PERSON WHO IS NOT A CIGARETTE MANUFACTURER, LICENSED SUBWHOLESALE, LICENSED VENDING MACHINE OPERATOR, OR LICENSED WHOLESALE.

(B) ADDITIONAL CAUSE FOR WHOLESALE LICENSE REVOCATION.

SUBJECT TO THE HEARING PROVISIONS OF § 16-211 OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE COMPTROLLER MAY REVOKE A LICENSE TO ACT AS A WHOLESALE IF THE LICENSEE VIOLATES TITLE 12 OF THE TAX - GENERAL ARTICLE.

(C) ADDITIONAL CAUSE FOR LICENSE DENIAL.

SUBJECT TO THE HEARING PROVISIONS OF § 16-211 OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE COMPTROLLER SHALL DENY A LICENSE TO ANY APPLICANT WHO HAS HAD A LICENSE REVOKED UNDER THIS SECTION UNTIL:

(1) 1 YEAR HAS PASSED SINCE THE LICENSE WAS REVOKED;
AND

(2) IT SATISFACTORILY APPEARS TO THE COMPTROLLER THAT THE APPLICANT WILL COMPLY WITH THIS TITLE AND ANY REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THIS TITLE.
