

SUBTITLE 3. LICENSE TO SELL CIGARETTES AT RETAIL IN COUNTIES.

16-301. LICENSE REQUIRED.

WHENEVER A PERSON SELLS CIGARETTES AT RETAIL IN A COUNTY, THE PERSON MUST HAVE A COUNTY LICENSE FOR:

(1) EACH PLACE OF BUSINESS; AND

(2) EACH VENDING MACHINE, IF THE APPLICANT SELLS CIGARETTES THROUGH A VENDING MACHINE.

16-302. APPLICATIONS FOR LICENSES.

FOR EACH COUNTY LICENSE, AN APPLICANT SHALL:

(1) SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE CLERK; AND

(2) PAY TO THE CLERK A LICENSE FEE OF \$25.

In item (2) of this subsection, the former phrase "for each place of business or vending machine" is deleted as unnecessary in light of § 16-301 of this subtitle.

16-303. ISSUANCE OF LICENSE.

THE CLERK SHALL ISSUE A COUNTY LICENSE TO EACH APPLICANT WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE.
