17-306. DISPLAY OF LICENSES.

THE HOLDER OF A LICENSE TO DO BUSINESS AT A PARTICULAR PLACE SPECIFIED IN THE LICENSE SHALL DISPLAY THE LICENSE CONSPICUOUSLY AT THAT PLACE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 56, § 11A(a)(1).

Former Art. 56, § 11A(a)(2), which required attaching a metal tag or stamp to a coin-operated machine, is deleted as duplicative of the provisions on attaching metal tags or stamps to vending machines in § 17-1905 of this title.

Former Art. 56, § 11A(a)(3), which required a license issued for a vehicle to be on the vehicle, is deleted as unnecessary in light of the more specific provisions of § 17-910 of this title that cover attaching a metal tag or stamp to a vehicle of a peddler.

Former Art. 56, § 11A(b), which required the Comptroller to seal a coin-operated machine or cigarette vending machine that did not properly display a license or metal tag or stamp until the violation was corrected in the presence of the Comptroller, is deleted as duplicative of provisions in § 16-219 of this article and § 17-1905 of this title. The notion of correcting a violation "in the presence of the Comptroller" is also impractical and contrary to practice.

17-307. CHANGE IN PLACE OF BUSINESS.

(A) ENDORSEMENT OF CHANGE.

(1) IF A SPECIFIC PLACE FOR DOING BUSINESS IS STATED IN A LICENSE, THE LICENSEE MAY CHANGE THE PLACE OF BUSINESS ONLY IF THE CLERK ENDORSES THE CHANGE ON THE LICENSE.

(2) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTIONS (B) AND (C) OF THIS SECTION, ON APPLICATION OF THE LICENSEE, THE CLERK SHALL ENDORSE THE CHANGE ON THE LICENSE.

(B) BALTIMORE COUNTY.

IN BALTIMORE COUNTY, THE CLERK MAY NOT ENDORSE A CHANGE IN THE PLACE OF BUSINESS UNTIL THE ZONING COMMISSIONER APPROVES THE NEW PLACE.

(C) WASHINGTON COUNTY.
