

SUBTITLE 4. AMUSEMENT DEVICES.

PART I. DEFINITIONS.

17-401. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language used as the standard introductory language to a definition section.

(B) FREE-PLAY CONSOLE MACHINE.

"FREE-PLAY CONSOLE MACHINE" MEANS A MACHINE THAT:

(1) HAS A BACKBOARD THAT DISPLAYS COMBINATIONS OF NUMBERS OR SYMBOLS;

(2) HAS 2 OR MORE REELS THAT SPIN ON THE INSERTION OF 1 OR MORE COINS OR TOKENS; AND

(3) WHEN THE REELS STOP ON COMBINATIONS THAT MATCH THOSE ON THE BACKBOARD, REWARDS THE PLAYER WITH A SPECIFIED NUMBER OF FREE GAMES, ALLOWING THE PLAYER TO CONTINUE TO PLAY THE MACHINE WITHOUT INSERTING ADDITIONAL COINS OR TOKENS.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language derived without substantive change from the fourth sentences, fifth sentences, and sixth sentences of former Art. 56, §§ 18(2) and 19(2).

In the introductory language of this subsection, the former references to a "mechanism" that is "encased in a wooden or metal cabinet" is deleted as surplusage.

(C) FREE-PLAY PINBALL MACHINE.

"FREE-PLAY PINBALL MACHINE" MEANS A MACHINE THAT:

(1) ON INSERTION OF 1 OR MORE COINS OR TOKENS, RELEASES 1 OR MORE BALLS FOR THE PLAYER TO PROPEL BY A PLUNGER; AND

(2) IF THE PLAYER GETS A CERTAIN SCORE OR COMBINATION OF NUMBERS, REWARDS THE PLAYER WITH A SPECIFIED NUMBER OF FREE GAMES, ALLOWING THE PLAYER TO CONTINUE TO PLAY THE MACHINE WITHOUT INSERTING ADDITIONAL COINS OR TOKENS.
