

17-402. COPIES OF LICENSES TO COMPTROLLER.

A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION THAT ISSUES A LICENSE FOR AN AMUSEMENT DEVICE SHALL SEND TO THE COMPTROLLER WITHIN 10 DAYS AFTER ISSUING THE LICENSE:

- (1) A COPY OF THE LICENSE;
- (2) THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE OWNER OF THE AMUSEMENT DEVICE;
- (3) THE LOCATION OF THE AMUSEMENT DEVICE;
- (4) THE NAME OF THE OWNER OF THE PLACE WHERE THE AMUSEMENT DEVICE IS LOCATED; AND
- (5) A DESCRIPTION OF THE AMUSEMENT DEVICE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 56, § 2B.

The Business Regulation Article Review Committee notes, for consideration by the General Assembly, that a political subdivision need not provide the name of the lessee of the place where the amusement device is located, only the name of the owner of the place.

17-405. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

(B) CONSOLE MACHINE LICENSE.

"CONSOLE MACHINE LICENSE" MEANS A LICENSE ISSUED BY THE CLERK TO KEEP A FREE-PLAY CONSOLE MACHINE FOR PUBLIC USE.
