

17-415. OPERATION BY MINORS PROHIBITED.

A PERSON WHO KEEPS A FREE-PLAY PINBALL MACHINE OR FREE-PLAY CONSOLE MACHINE FOR PUBLIC USE MAY NOT ALLOW A MINOR TO OPERATE THE FREE-PLAY PINBALL MACHINE OR FREE-PLAY CONSOLE MACHINE.

17-416. KEEPING PINBALL MACHINES IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY.

(A) SCOPE OF SECTION.

THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO FREE-PLAY PINBALL MACHINES THAT ARE IN LOCKED STORAGE AND NOT AVAILABLE FOR PUBLIC USE.

(B) NUMBER OF MACHINES PER FLOOR.

IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY, NOT MORE THAN 2 FREE-PLAY PINBALL MACHINES MAY BE KEPT ON THE SAME FLOOR OF A BUILDING.

17-417. PENALTIES.

(A) IN GENERAL.

EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, A PERSON WHO VIOLATES PART II OF THIS SUBTITLE IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND, ON CONVICTION, IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$100 FOR EACH VIOLATION.

(B) MONTGOMERY COUNTY.

IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY, A PERSON WHO VIOLATES PART II OF THIS SUBTITLE IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND, ON CONVICTION, IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$500 FOR EACH VIOLATION.
