(C) DO CONSTRUCTION BUSINESS.

- (2) EXCAVATE EARTH, ROCK, OR OTHER MATERIAL FOR A FOUNDATION OR OTHER PURPOSE; OR
- (3) DO WORK ON OR IN A BUILDING OR OTHER STRUCTURE THAT REQUIRES THE USE OF A BUILDING MATERIAL, INCLUDING:
 - (I) PAINT:
 - (II) STONE;
 - (III) BRICK;
 - (IV) MORTAR;
 - (V) WOOD;
 - (VI) CEMENT;
 - (VII) STRUCTURAL IRON;
 - (VIII) STRUCTURAL STEEL;
 - (IX) SHEET IRON;
 - (X) GALVANIZED IRON;
 - (XI) METALLIC PIPING;
 - (XII) TIN:
 - (XIII) LEAD;
 - (XIV) ELECTRIC WIRING; OR
 - (XV) ANY OTHER METAL.
