17-703. LICENSE FEES.

AN APPLICANT FOR A WHOLESALE FARM MACHINERY DEALER'S LICENSE SHALL PAY TO THE CLERK A LICENSE FEE OF:

- (1) S50 FOR A BUSINESS IN A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION WITH A POPULATION OF NOT MORE THAN 10,000;
- (2) S100 FOR A BUSINESS IN A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION WITH A POPULATION OF 10,001 TO 50,000; OR
- (3) \$200 FOR A BUSINESS IN A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION WITH A POPULATION OF MORE THAN 50,000.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 56, § 173(1) through (3) and the reference to paying a license fee in the introductory language of that section.

In items (1), (2), and (3) of this section, the references to a "municipal corporation" are substituted for the former references to "cities" and "towns" to conform to Md. Constitution Art. XI-E.

The Business Regulation Article Review Committee notes, for consideration by the General Assembly, that a license fee is not specified for an applicant whose business is outside of a municipal corporation.

SUBTITLE 8. GARAGES.

17-801. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.
