(D) ONE HORSE PEDDLER.

"ONE HORSE PEDDLER" MEANS A PEDDLER WHO TRAVELS WITH A WAGON OR OTHER VEHICLE DRAWN BY 1 HORSE OR OTHER BEAST OF BURDEN.

(E) TWO HORSE PEDDLER.

"TWO HORSE PEDDLER" MEANS A PEDDLER WHO TRAVELS WITH A WAGON OR OTHER VEHICLE DRAWN BY 2 HORSES OR OTHER BEASTS OF BURDEN.
