

(IV) THE TIMES OF DAY AND THE NUMBER OF DAYS PER MONTH THAT THE APPLICANT IS ALLOWED TO DO BUSINESS ON THE PROPERTY OF THE OWNER OR LESSEE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 56, § 21(d)(2) and the first through third sentences of § 23.

In subsection (a)(2), (3), (4), and (5) of this section, the terms "foot peddler", "one horse peddler", "two horse peddler", and "motor vehicle peddler", respectively, are substituted for the former references to "travel on foot", "travel with a horse or other beast of burden and a wagon or other vehicle", "travel with two horses or other beast of burden and a wagon or other vehicle", and "travel with a motor truck or motor vehicle of any description", respectively, to use the defined terms.

17-908. ISSUANCE OF TAG OR STAMP.

THE CLERK SHALL PROVIDE A METAL TAG OR STAMP TO EACH ONE HORSE PEDDLER, TWO HORSE PEDDLER, OR MOTOR VEHICLE PEDDLER WHO HOLDS A PEDDLER LICENSE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from the fourth sentence of former Art. 56, § 23, as it related to a tag or stamp being provided to licensees.

The first sentence of former Art. 56, § 24, which provided that a peddler license may be issued to an individual, partnership, or corporation, is deleted as an unnecessary statement of the obvious.
