

A PERSON MAY NOT ACT AS A NONRESIDENT ITINERANT MAGAZINE SELLER IN CALVERT COUNTY UNLESS THE PERSON HAS A MAGAZINE SELLER LICENSE.

(B) PENALTY.

A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND, ON CONVICTION, IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$300.

SUBTITLE 10. JUNK DEALERS AND SCRAP METAL PROCESSORS.

PART I. DEFINITIONS; GENERAL PROVISIONS.

17-1001. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(B) AGENT.

"AGENT" MEANS A PERSON WHO BUYS OR SELLS JUNK OR SCRAP METAL FOR A JUNK DEALER OR SCRAP METAL PROCESSOR.
