- (9) USED FARM MACHINERY; AND
- (10) ANY OTHER SIMILAR USED MATERIAL.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 56, § 233(a), except the phrase "as used in this section".

In the introductory language of this subsection, the word "includes" is substituted for the former words "shall mean" since the definition is meant to be illustrative, not comprehensive.

In item (1)(ii) of this subsection, the reference to "Babbitt metal" is substituted for the former reference to "babbits" to use the more commonly used term.

In item (1)(viii) of this subsection, the comma in the term "low carbon, chrome" is deleted to correct an apparent error in punctuation.

In item (2) of this subsection, the former word "ranges" is deleted as included in the more comprehensive word "stoves".

In item (3) of this subsection, the former reference to "water faucets" is deleted as included in the reference to "plumbing fixtures and supplies".

(D) JUNK DEALER; SCRAP METAL PROCESSOR.

"JUNK DEALER" OR "SCRAP METAL PROCESSOR" MEANS A PERSON WHO DOES BUSINESS BUYING OR SELLING JUNK OR SCRAP METAL.
