Occasionally, the term "junk dealer or scrap metal processor licensee" is used to refer to the holder of a junk dealer or scrap metal processor license. Since "junk dealer or scrap metal processor license" is defined in this section, "junk dealer or scrap metal processor licensee" need not be defined separately.

"Junk dealer; scrap metal processor" § 17-1001

(D) NONRESIDENT JUNK DEALER; NONRESIDENT SCRAP METAL PROCESSOR.

"NONRESIDENT JUNK DEALER" OR "NONRESIDENT SCRAP METAL PROCESSOR" MEANS A JUNK DEALER OR SCRAP METAL PROCESSOR WHO IS NOT A RESIDENT OF THE STATE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 56, § 233(c).

The former definitions of "nonresident junk dealer's agent" and "nonresident scrap metal processor's agent" are deleted because these terms are not used in the revision.

The Business Regulation Article Review Committee notes, for consideration by the General Assembly, that this definition does not clearly cover corporations since it does not refer to a principal place of business or place of incorporation.

(E) STATE JUNK LICENSE.

"STATE JUNK LICENSE" INCLUDES:

- (1) A JUNK DEALER OR SCRAP METAL PROCESSOR LICENSE;
 - (2) AN AGENT LICENSE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language added to provide a specific listing of the two different licenses covered under the defined term.

Occasionally, the term "State junk licensee" is used to refer to the holder of any of the licenses included in the definition of "State junk license". Since "State junk license" is defined in this subsection, "State junk licensee" need not be defined separately.
