## 17-1805. CHAIN STORE LICENSE REQUIRED.

A PERSON MUST HAVE A CHAIN STORE LICENSE WHENEVER THE PERSON OPERATES 2 OR MORE RETAIL STORES UNDER THE SAME GENERAL MANAGEMENT OR OWNERSHIP IN THE STATE.

## 17-1806. APPLICATIONS FOR LICENSES.

(A) APPLICATION FOR PLACE OF BUSINESS.

AN APPLICANT FOR A TRADER'S LICENSE SHALL STATE IN THE APPLICATION THE PLACE WHERE THE APPLICANT WILL DO BUSINESS AS A TRADER.

- (B) VISUALLY HANDICAPPED APPLICANTS; BLIND INDUSTRIES.
- (1) THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY IF THE AVERAGE VALUE OF THE APPLICANT'S STOCK IN TRADE EXCEEDS \$10,000.
- (2) AN APPLICANT FOR A TRADER'S LICENSE MAY APPLY UNDER THIS SUBSECTION IF THE APPLICANT HAS A DEFECT IN VISION SUCH THAT:
- (I) VISUAL ACUITY IN THE APPLICANT'S BETTER EYE DOES NOT EXCEED 20/140 WITH CORRECTING LENSES; OR
