17-1810. CONTENTS OF LICENSE.

THE CLERK SHALL STATE ON EACH TRADER'S LICENSE THE PLACE WHERE THE LICENSED TRADER MAY DO BUSINESS AS A TRADER.

17-1811. SCOPE OF LICENSE.

(A) IN GENERAL.

(1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A TRADER'S LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE HOLDER TO OFFER GOODS FOR SALE IN ANY PART OF THE STATE.

(2) HOWEVER, A TRADER MAY KEEP A STORE OR FIXED PLACE OF BUSINESS ONLY AT THE PLACE STATED IN THE TRADER'S LICENSE.

(B) EXHIBITORS.

A TRADER'S LICENSE ISSUED TO AN EXHIBITOR AUTHORIZES THE HOLDER TO DO BUSINESS AS AN EXHIBITOR AT ANY SHOW IN THE STATE.
