- (2) (I) IN HOWARD COUNTY, THE CLERK MAY NOT ISSUE A TRANSFERRED TRADER'S LICENSE WITHOUT THE APPROVAL OF THE DIRECTOR OF THE OFFICE OF PLANNING AND ZONING.
- (II) WITHIN 3 WORKING DAYS AFTER AN APPLICATION FOR ISSUANCE OF A TRANSFERRED TRADER'S LICENSE IS SUBMITTED FOR REVIEW BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE OFFICE OF PLANNING AND ZONING, THE DIRECTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE CLERK OF THE APPROVAL OR DISAPPROVAL OF THE APPLICATION.
 - (E) TERM OF TRANSFERRED LICENSE.

A PERSON WHO BUYS A TRADER'S LICENSE MAY DO BUSINESS AS A TRADER FOR THE REST OF THE TERM OF THE TRADER'S LICENSE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 56, §§ 61, 62, the fourth and fifth sentences of § 2, as those sentences related to transferred licenses, and the fourth sentence of § 56.

In subsection (d) of this section, the former references to a "designated agent" are deleted as surplusage.

The Business Regulation Article Review Committee notes, for consideration by the General Assembly, that the approval of the zoning authorities required by subsection (d) of this section seems needless because the new owner of the business should be able to do business under the old owner's license with the current zoning approval for that license.

17-1814. DUTIES OF PROMOTER AT SHOW.

(A) WHEN EXHIBITOR ALLOWED TO DO BUSINESS.

A PROMOTER MAY NOT ALLOW AN EXHIBITOR TO DO BUSINESS AT A SHOW UNLESS, BEFORE THE SHOW, THE EXHIBITOR SUBMITS TO THE PROMOTER:

- (1) A PHOTOCOPY OF THE TRADER'S LICENSE OF THE EXHIBITOR; OR
- (2) AN EXHIBITOR'S AFFIDAVIT IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 17–1804(D)(1)(II) OF THIS SUBTITLE.
 - (B) DISPLAY OF LICENSE OR AFFIDAVIT.
